PAYMENT OPTIONS

- Pay 50% upon registration with remainder on post-dated cheque dated no later than Dec. 1st, 2011.
- Session 2 Registration is to be paid before Dec. 23rd.
- There will be a \$25 charge for any cheque returned NSF. Certified cheque or cash will be required thereafter.
- Family discount for three or more skaters; ½ price on lowest priced membership.
- Guest skaters are to pay an executive member or the club coach on the session.

PROGRAMS OFFERED

Sanctioned by Skate Canada

BEGINNER CANSKATE

Stage 1. At this level, skaters learn how to stand up, fall down, get up, move forward and change direction. CSA approved helmets are mandatory.

CANSKATE

Stages 2-5. This level of the program combines fun with the basics of skating forward, backward, stopping, using edges (gliding), while building power and speed. This program prepares the skater to move on to the next levels of skating: Figure, Hockey, Ringette, Synchronized, CanPower, etc., if available. CSA approved helmets are mandatory.

STAR-CANSKATE

This program is designed for the young aspiring figure skater. Skaters invited into this program will continue to skate during the CanSkate session while being slowly introduced to the Starskate program on the Intermediate session 1 night a week. Skaters will be given group lessons in the following disciplines: skills, ice dancing, free-skate, interpretive, & synchronized skating. Private lessons are highly recommended. Skaters must be working on the Stage 4 or 5 badge. CSA approved helmets are mandatory.

INTERMEDIATE

Stages 6 & 7. Skate Canada Test Stream: Skaters work on Freeskate, Dance, Skills and Stroking at specific times with the club coach(es). This program is ideal as it allows the skater to utilize club coaching as well as having the option to arrange additional private lessons with a freelance coach.

SENIOR

This Program offers Skate Canada Test Stream up to Diamond level dances. There is no club coaching offered in this program and coaching must be arranged between the skater/parent and the freelance coaches of your choice. See professional staff section.

CAN-POWERSKATE

The CanPOWERskate Program is more comprehensive than ever, with additional levels. Skaters will develop better balance, power, agility, speed and endurance as they learn and improve upon skating fundamentals. Helmets are mandatory.

ADULT SKATING

Adult skating is growing in popularity and more and more clubs are offering recreational, test and competitive opportunities to this segment of the population. Adults participate in CanSkate, STARSkate and CanPowerSkate programs as well as on synchronized skating teams. Adult championships currently provide opportunities to adult skaters to experience the challenge of a competition in a fun, social environment. Skate Canada is currently expanding its programming in this area.

SPECIAL NEEDS

The Collingwood Skating Club is very proud to be a registered club of Special Olympics Ontario. Skaters with an intellectual disability are integrated into the appropriate Skate Canada program. Competition opportunities are available through Skate Canada & Special Olympics at the Regional, Provincial, National & World levels.
