COVID-19 101 Safety Protocols

The Collingwood Skating Club and its members will be required to follow the below safety rules and regulations in order to provide the safest environment for all its participants and attendees. Skaters, Club Board members and parents will ensure that the following measures are abided by. Failure to respect the wellbeing of others and safety measures in place can result in removal from the arena and the Club.

- Skaters are to arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to their start time ready to skate and are asked to wait outside the main doors of Central Arena.
- **All skaters must check in at the registration table before the start of each session.** The Coaching Liaison or a member of the Board will complete Health Screening Questionnaire and Session Tracking sheet for each on ice program. Skaters not feeling well or have any COVID-19 symptoms must not attend skating session
- All must sanitize hands before entering and upon exit the arena.
- If need be skaters will be allowed to put on their skates inside the arena in designated chairs/areas. 1 parent/care giver may assist with tying skates for younger skaters and removing skates at the end of the session and then leave the building
- Spectators are not permitted until further notice
- Masks to be worn by all who enter the arena. Skaters may remove masks just before going on ice. Skaters can continue to wear masks on ice if they prefer.
- Dressing rooms will not be available.
- The main entrance is to be used for entry and exit will be the side doors of the arena.
- Skaters must sanitize their hands when getting off the ice
- Skaters must bring their own water bottles - no sharing of food or beverages during the sessions - No water fill station is available at the arena so bring a prefilled bottle
- Sessions will be structured to ensure social distancing as much as possible
- to ensure start times are closely adhered to parents are asked to pick up the skaters promptly at the end of each session.
- Skaters must remove their skates and exit the arena immediately after their session. (in the case where assistance is required to remove skates, parents will be allowed to come back in 5 minutes prior to the end of your skaters session. Parents will meet their skater at their designated chair and will immediately remove their skates, collect all personal items and leave the building.)
